Podcast

Our podcast remains the heart of our resources and content. In 2024, we grew to over 600,000 downloads, with our daily devotional podcast surpassing 70,000. Unlike standard podcasts which typically run 13 weeks, we release a brand-new episode every single week (52 weeks), covering the topics single parents face most. From heartfelt conversations with solo parents to insights from incredible guest experts and thought leaders, we're honored to provide content that equips, encourages, and empowers.



Online Resources

Through our website, written materials, and social media, we've created a constant source of encouragement for single parents. Daily posts provide connection and remind solo parents they are never alone—they're part of a larger community that cares.



CRM

For the first time, we've implemented a powerful CRM system, allowing us to stay in closer contact with donors, partners, and single parents. This new tool has transformed how we build meaningful, consistent communication.



Groups

We continue offering free Solo Parent support groups seven days a week—many days with multiple opportunities to connect. These groups are led by inspiring solo parent leaders who've walked their own healing journeys through Solo Parent and now help others find hope and healing. Without any formal promotion, we've also seen in-person local Solo Parent groups take off in churches and corporations eager to serve their local communities. Solo Parent App

Our app has become a central hub, putting resources at solo parents' fingertips. Even more exciting are the 7,000 single parents around the world accessing real-time chat to share best practices, prayer requests, and encouragement. It's a powerful tool for connection and community, especially for those who feel isolated.



Employees

2024 marked another milestone—we transitioned from part-time and contract help to W-2 employees with benefits. Investing in our team reflects our commitment to building a strong foundation for the future.

Military Partnerships

In 2023, we were honored to be invited to the Pentagon to collaborate on creating a support program for single-parent service members—a group that, incredibly, had never received tailored support in the history of the U.S. Armed Forces. Working closely with high-ranking officials, we developed two programs from the ground up. While we were told the approval process could take 12-18 months, the programs were approved in just two weeks, making history as the first-ever support initiative for single parents in the U.S. military.

2024 became a year of unprecedented progress. We trained 90 Army chaplains, equipping them to serve 38,000 service members and their families. But the impact didn't stop there. The Pentagon itself embraced our program, offering our support groups internally, serving all military branches and even offering it to their civilian employees. Now, this historic initiative serves 24,000 individuals working at the Pentagon itself.

This milestone underscores not only the urgent need but also the immense opportunity to support single parents who serve our country with such bravery. We remain humbled and deeply honored to walk alongside these men and women. Looking ahead, we're excited to expand this program further within the military and continue making history by addressing a need that has been overlooked for far too long.





State-Level Expansion

A surprising and exciting development in 2024 came from the state of Florida. After learning about our work with the Pentagon, state leaders asked if our programs could be adapted to support first responders, law enforcement officers, and veterans—those in high-stress roles who often face the unique challenges of solo parenting.

In partnership with senators and legislators, we worked to develop a tailored approach that met these needs. The result was the passage of an appropriations bill that received bipartisan support in both the House and Senate. This legislation allocated funding in Florida's 2024 budget to provide free resources and support to single parents in these critical professions.

This initiative has not only deepened our impact in Florida but also opened the door to future collaborations with other states. We are grateful for the opportunity to serve these dedicated individuals who sacrifice so much for their communities and look forward to scaling this model nationwide.

Solo Parent Academy

For years, we've dreamed of creating a way for single parents to access resources directly—whether or not they're connected to a church, organization, or institution. In 2024, that dream began to take shape with the launch of the Solo Parent Academy. Our first course, "Four Habits of a Successful Solo Parent," equips solo parents with practical tools for building stability, fostering emotional health, and finding hope. This course marks the start of a comprehensive library of content designed specifically to meet the needs of single parents.

The Solo Parent Academy is more than just an online course platform. It's a place where solo parents can find encouragement, learn at their own pace, and feel empowered to navigate their unique challenges. Over the next year, we will be developing additional courses, covering topics ranging from co-parenting strategies to financial planning, to emotional wellness.

This Academy represents a significant step toward fulfilling our mission: to equip and empower every single parent, no matter where they are, with the resources they need to thrive.





Digital Platform

From the very beginning, we recognized the power of digital tools in reaching single parents. However, relying on third-party platforms for our app and website has limited what we can offer. In 2024, we began an ambitious project to build a proprietary digital platform designed specifically for the needs of single parents.

This new platform will integrate all of our resources into a seamless, user-friendly experience. The first feature, launched in late 2024, was the Solo Parent Academy, with its inaugural course available online. But this is just the beginning. By early 2025, all of our digital resources—including support group access, devotional content, and community chat—will transition to this new platform.

The most exciting aspect of this proprietary system is the ability to customize it entirely for single parents. Whether it's real-time chat for sharing encouragement, personalized resources based on individual needs, or streamlined access to new content, this platform will provide a comprehensive and dynamic hub for support.

This digital transformation is more than a technological upgrade—it's a commitment to serving single parents better, eliminating barriers, and creating a space where they feel equipped, connected, and supported.


Fueling Our Mission: Strategic Budget Allocation for Growth and Impact

Importantly, we achieved this while keeping our primary financial investment directed toward program development, ensuring our mission remains the central focus.

As we enter 2025 and 2026, we will concentrate on expanding our reach significantly. With this infrastructure now in place, we seek additional resources to extend our impact further. To use an analogy, we've built the car through your support; now we need gas to drive our mission forward.

Self-Sustainability

In 2024, we gained a clear road map for providing resources to military and government sectors. These areas, which we initially identified as promising avenues for self-sustainability, have now proven their potential after nine months of actively selling our programs. Our belief and forecast have been validated: we now project that within the next 18 months, 60% of our operational overhead will be covered by these initiatives.

However, meeting the growing demand has required significant investment in the infrastructure necessary to service these opportunities. To sustain this growth, we need donor support during this critical transition.

Our plan is twofold:

- 1. Phase One (First 18 Months): Donor support will need to cover 60% of our operational costs, requiring \$800,000 annually.
- 2. Phase Two (Second 18 Months): Donor support will decrease to 30% as we move closer to self-sustainability.

By the third year, our overhead will no longer rely on donor contributions, allowing us to channel future donations directly into expansion efforts, such as serving low-income populations and launching benevolence programs. This strategy ensures we can achieve self-sustainability while continuing to scale our impact.

321 Mobilization

In 1984, President Ronald Reagan proclaimed **March 21** as **National Single Parent Day**—the first and only time a U.S. president officially recognized this demographic. Despite this recognition, little has been done since to support or celebrate single parents.

In previous years, we marked this date with a fundraiser called "321." Starting in 2025, we're pivoting this effort into a nationwide awareness campaign. This campaign will culminate in an event on the Thursday before March 21, aiming to inspire people to honor, support, and celebrate the single parents in their lives.

Our role will be to shine a spotlight on the importance of single parents, equipping individuals, organizations, and institutions like the military with the tools and resources they need to celebrate and support this under served group. This shift moves the focus away from us as an organization and positions us as a thought leader, mobilizing the country to pay attention to this vital demographic.

In 2026, to make this vision a reality, we aim to raise \$120,000 to fund this nationwide effort.

Military Expansion

With the launch of support groups at the Pentagon, awareness of our programs is spreading beyond the Army branch. Our goal is to serve all branches of the Armed Forces.

Expanding this initiative will require significant infrastructure and support, including:

- Customization: Adapting materials and programs originally developed for the Army to meet the unique needs of other branches.
- Dedicated Liaisons: Establishing key personnel to manage relationships and provide customer service for each branch.
- Training: Recruiting and equipping trainers to prepare chaplains across all branches to care for single parents.

This expansion is a vital next step in addressing the needs of single-parent service members throughout the military. By creating tailored programs and resources, we can ensure no branch or individual is left unsupported.


Digital Resources

Our new proprietary platform has opened the door to provide a more robust and tailored experience for single parents. Until now, much of our content has been broad, addressing the general challenges faced by widowed, divorced, and never-married parents. While this approach has been valuable, it doesn't fully address the nuanced needs of specific groups within the single-parent community.

Whether it's support for parents of children with special needs, navigating complex co-parenting relationships, or dealing with grief after losing a spouse, these unique experiences require focused resources. General content simply can't go deep enough to address these crisis points.

Our vision is to build a comprehensive library of resources that speaks to every facet of a single parent's life. In 2025, we plan to produce 12 to 15 video courses as the foundation of this library. These courses will address specific, immediate needs while laying the groundwork for a dynamic platform that evolves alongside the challenges single parents face.

This ongoing effort is about more than just creating content—it's about ensuring single parents have access to expert guidance and tools that meet them exactly where they are, no matter their circumstances.



It's very hard to do this parenting thing, period. And then when you're doing it by yourself...being in a group of people who are also doing this alone is empowering and encourages you to keep going. And not only just to push through the hard things, but also come alongside you with a sense of love and care. You're able to do it with each other. **–Stephanie**
